Briefly describe the intern's assignment John is working for the National Hurricane Program technology modernization effort in Group 44. John's specific project is to develop an Android mobile application that allows emergency managers using our HVX web platform to notify the public (i.e. the application's users) of hurricane evacuations. The mobile app should notify users of evacuations based on their GPS location, provide them with situational awareness like shelter locations and evacuation zone data, provide evacuation routes and directions capabilities, and allow the users to provide some sort of feedback about their intentions.
